221 FENCE STAIN CONCENTRATE

CEDAR DARK BROWN REDWOOD LIGHT BROWN

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: Eco Chemical 221 Fence Stain Concentrate dilutes with water to produce a superior water-based alkyd oil stain for virtually any species of softwood fence board or framing, including pressure treated wood. Eco 221 provides the superior protection of a penetrating oil stain with top quality oxide colorants for lasting color and highly effective biocides to resist mold and mildew.

This product is concentrated and must be diluted with 2 parts water to 1-part product, to create an effective working stain solution. The concentrate must be thoroughly mixed, then combined with 2 parts water for each part stain concentrate. The working solution should be stirred frequently during the application period to prevent settling or separation.

SURFACE PREPARATION: Any previously applied stains or sealers should be completely removed. Any surface soil, including oil or grease stains, mold or mildew should be removed. Strippers or cleaners must be completely rinsed off and the fence surface allowed to be dry to the touch before staining.

APPLICATION: Do not use if rain is expected within 24hrs. Apply at temperatures above 45 Degrees F and below 95 Degrees F. The stain working solution can be easily applied using a brush or roller, garden pump sprayer or airless sprayer. One generous coating is recommended. If a second coat is to be applied, allow no more than 25 minutes between coats. The stain should be dry to the touch in under 6 hours. Actual drying time will vary depending on temperature and humidity.

COVERAGE: Coverage can vary widely depending on the age & condition of the wood and choice of application method. On average, one gallon of prepared stain can cover up to 150 square feet of new wood.

CLEAN-UP AND STORAGE: Tools can be cleaned easily with soap and water. Drips or stain marks on walkways, plants, etc. should be cleaned up before they dry by thorough rinsing of the areas with a garden hose.

Leftover concentrate can be stored for re-use for up to 6 months in a cool space in an air-tight container, protected from freezing.



DISPOSAL: Never pour left over material down a drain or sink. Do not incinerate closed containers. For more precise disposal guidelines in your area, contact your local waste management agency.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS: Use with adequate ventilation. Keep out of reach of children. Close container after use. If spraying, use approved NIOSH/MSHA respirator. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. If splashed into eyes, rinse with clean water for 15 minutes. If skin irritation occurs, wash area with soap and water. Do not take internally. If accidentally ingested, immediately drink two glasses of water and contact a physician. DO NOT induce vomiting.
